Who Can Apply?

The externship is open to medical students enrolled in their 4th year of an LCME accredited school of Medicine. The student should identify as underrepresented in medicine (URIM). This includes, but is not limited to, Black, Indigenous, or Person of Color (including African or Caribbean, Latinx, Native Americans, Asian, Middle Eastern, Indian, and Pacific Island heritage) and students from the LGBTQ community.

It offers selected externs a \$1000 scholarship per year for travel, lodging, and other expenses.

All interested students must apply via VSAS in addition to the URM application. Applications reviewed on a rolling basis starting April 11, 2022.
